## Regulations for Yuan Ze University Student Affair Committee

- Article 1: To promote Student Affairs and implement student counseling work, the Student Affairs Committee Meeting (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") was established following Article 10 of the school's organizational regulations.
- Article 2: The Committee shall review the following matters:
  - 1.Student Affairs regulations.
  - 2. Student Affairs' major work plans.
  - 3. Other issues related to Student Affairs.
- Article 3: The Committee will consist of 7-13 members, including the Dean of Student Affairs, the Dean of Global Affairs, the Director of the Physical Education Office, the Military Training Director, the heads of each academic department (or equivalent units), and student representatives.

The student representatives are chosen through an open process, including one to five members elected from the Autonomous Student Organization, five to ten representatives nominated by each college, and one graduate student representative, who is elected on a rotating basis according to the order of college establishment.

Article 4: Committee members are appointed for a term of one year, with the possibility

of renewal. In case a member of the Committee is unable to attend a meeting due to special circumstances, they can entrust a proxy to attend and perform their duties.

- Article 5: The Committee shall be chaired by the Dean of Student Affairs or an appointed representative by the Dean of Student Affairs when convened. The Committee must have a quorum with the presence of at least half of the members to proceed with the meeting.
- Article 6: In principle, the Committee will take place once every semester. Extraordinary meetings can be scheduled when necessary, and a task force could be set up to manage meetings submitted by the Committee and other related issues.
- Article 7: The Committee may invite relevant personnel and students to attend upon its convening.
- Article 8: After approval from the Executive Council Meeting, these regulations will become effective and any amendments will follow the same process.
