

Yuan Ze University Student Clubs Publication Guidance Principles

Ratified at the 4th Discipline Committee Meeting on 12 July 1990

Amended at the 5th Discipline Committee Meeting on 17 March 1991

Amended at the 5th revision of the Discipline Committee Meeting on 8 July 1993

Amended at the 1st Student Affairs Steering Meeting of the academic year on 13 August 1996

Clause 1: These principles are set with the goal to encourage students' artistic creation, improve the academic research atmosphere of student Clubs, and guide their publications.

Clause 2: Registration of Publications

1. The organizational publications of students refer to newspapers, newsletters, magazines and other written documents or electronic materials published by various organizations/clubs.
2. The creation of a publication requires filling out the “Application Form for Registering Organizational Publications” and submitting the details to the Extracurricular Activities Section for the review and approval.

Clause 3: Document/Script Review

1. Counseling:
 - a. Publications of autonomous association: The guidance counselors from departments with the affiliated association are responsible for providing counselling in script reviews.
 - b. General club publications: The guidance club counselors are responsible for providing counselling in script reviews.
2. The reviews of article contents should comply with national policies and regulations.
3. If the organizations do not agree to the disapproval of the suggested publication contents, an application for a second review may be submitted. The Office of Student Affairs will then invite instructors with pertinent specialization, the guidance counselors of the organizations, Student Affairs Office faculty, and organization/club leaders to formulate a re-evaluation committee. If necessary, the club writer of the article will be invited to the meeting for further explanation.
4. After the publication of each article, the original text should have been kept for three months for reference purposes.

Clause 4: These principles shall be implemented after being approved by the Student Activities Committee, and the same situations should be applied when revised.

If any controversies or disputes occurred regarding the clauses of the regulations, it shall always refer to the Chinese version.
