Article 1 These Regulations are formulated to express gratitude to donors who contribute to the University's development.

Article 2 The names of donors or donor organizations and donation details shall be published regularly on the University's website and relevant publications. A letter of appreciation will be issued to donors.

Article 3 A record of all donations shall be displayed in the University History Galley. Additionally, an annual donor honor roll shall be published. For individual donations exceeding NT\$1 million, the donor's name shall be permanently listed.

Article 4 Donors shall be thanked according to the following methods:

1. All donors shall be acknowledged on the University's website as part of the donor list.
2. Donors contributing NT\$10,000 or more shall receive a letter of appreciation from the President.
3. Donors contributing NT\$100,000 or more shall receive a certificate of appreciation and a letter from the President.
4. Donors contributing NT\$1 million or more shall receive a commemorative plaque and a letter of appreciation from the President.
5. Donors contributing NT\$3 million or more shall receive a commemorative plaque and a letter of appreciation from the Chairperson of the Board.
6. Donors contributing NT\$10 million or more shall receive a commemorative plaque, a letter of appreciation from the Chairperson of the Board, and a commemorative plaque displayed in the University History Galley and honored as Distinguished Alumni.
7. Donors contributing NT\$30 million or more shall receive special recognition under a dedicated plan.

Article 5 Donors contributing to the construction of buildings or facilities shall be honored as Distinguished Alumni and may have the building or facility named after them for perpetuity. The naming of such buildings or facilities shall be approved by the University Council and the Board of trustee. The specific donation amount required for naming rights shall be determined separately.

Article 6 Donors shall receive recognition for cumulative donations that meet the thresholds specified in the preceding articles by these Regulations.

Article 7 Donors contributing equipment related to teaching or research shall have their donation acknowledged by a label on the donated equipment. Recognition shall be given according to the value of the donation as specified in these Regulations. If the donation meets the reward standards under the Ministry of Education's Regulations on Rewards for Educational Donations, the University shall report it to the government for commendation.

Article 8 Donor recognition shall respect the donor's wishes. If a donor prefers anonymity, the University shall maintain strict confidentiality.

Article 9 These Regulations shall take effect upon, approval by the Executive Council Meeting, and ratification by the Chairperson of the Board. The same procedure applies to amendments.

In case of any discrepancy between the Chinese and English versions, the Chinese version shall prevail.
