

Key Points for Yuan Ze University English Proficiency Exam Rewards

1. In order to enhance the English proficiency of undergraduate students at Yuan Ze University, the “Procedures for Yuan Ze University English Proficiency Exam Rewards” (referred to as “these procedures” below) are especially established.
2. Undergraduate students at Yuan Ze University (referred to as “the university” below) who participate in the specified exams during their academic tenure and meet the reward criteria as outlined in these procedures will be granted a reward by the university as an encouragement.
3. Qualified Applicants:
 - (A) Undergraduate students admitted from the 105 academic year (2016) onwards (excluding any English program majors and the Department of Applied Foreign Languages) who participate in the specified exams during their freshman and sophomore years and meet the application requirements.
 - (B) Regarding freshmen, their eligibility begins from August 1st of the current academic year.
4. The “specified exams” in Article 2 of these procedures and the criteria for granting rewards are as follows :

5. Application Steps:

- (A) Following the announcement of these reward regulations, applicants who meet the application criteria must submit an application form, their student ID card (original and copy), and their score transcript (original and copy). The application period is before November 30th in the first semester and before May 31st of the second semester. Rewards will be issued once per semester.

(B) Applicants should submit transcripts within six months from the date the transcript is issued. If the issuance date is not indicated on the transcript, the examination date indicated on the transcript will be used as the basis for calculation.

6. To ensure fairness, only students with active enrollment status can apply during their academic tenure; individuals are limited to one application. Applicants who submit applications after the deadline will be considered for the following semester's application. As for applicants who are in their sophomore year and submit applications after the sophomore-year second-semester deadline, if the date of the score acquisition falls within their sophomore year, their application documents may be considered for the following semester.

7. These guidelines have taken effect since they were approved in the university Executive Council Meeting. The process will be the same for any amendments.
