Yuan Ze University Implementation Regulations for Learning Assistance Grants

for Students with Disabilities

Passed during the 3rd Student Affairs Meeting of the 106th Academic Year on March 15, 2018 Amended during the 5th Student Affairs Meeting of the 106th Academic Year on May 10, 2018 Amended during the 1st Student Affairs Meeting of the 109th Academic Year on December 16, 2020

Article 1: In accordance with the Executive Yuan's approved Higher Education Enhancement Project (hereinafter referred to as the Higher Education Enhancement Project), and to strengthen psychological health care for students with disabilities, enhance their self-directed learning abilities, and in accordance with Article 32, Paragraph 3 of the Special Education Act, Yuan Ze University hereby establishes these regulations to provide learning assistance grants.

Article 2: Eligibility and Qualifications for Applying for Learning Assistance Grants

Students holding the Ministry of Education's certificate of special education student identification and the Association for Student Counseling and Guidance certificate (hereinafter referred to as the special education identification certificate).

Those meeting the household income criteria specified in Article 3 of the Regulations on Tuition Fee Reduction for Students with Disabilities and Children of Persons with Disabilities.

For undergraduate students, achieving an average academic score of 60 or above in the previous semester and an average conduct score of 85 or above.

For master's and doctoral students, achieving an average academic score of 70 or above in the previous semester and an average conduct score of 85 or above.

Article 3: Application Regulations and Timeline for Learning Assistance Grants

Applicants must submit the following documents:

(1) Application form.

(2) Copy of student ID.

(3) Copy of the special education identification certificate.

(4) Official transcript of the previous semester.

Applications are processed once per semester. Eligible applicants must apply to the Counseling and Career Guidance Division of the Student Affairs Office within one month after the start of classes, according to the announcement.

Article 4: Regulations for Approval of Learning Assistance Grants

Execution of the grant is based on the budget allocated by the Ministry of Education, and grants are disbursed according to academic performance.

According to Article 4 of the Regulations on Awards and Subsidies for Special Education Students, those who have received similar government subsidies are not eligible to apply for this learning assistance grant.

Article 5: Detailed implementation rules of these regulations shall be separately established.

Article 6: These regulations shall be implemented upon approval by the Student Affairs Meeting and amended accordingly.
